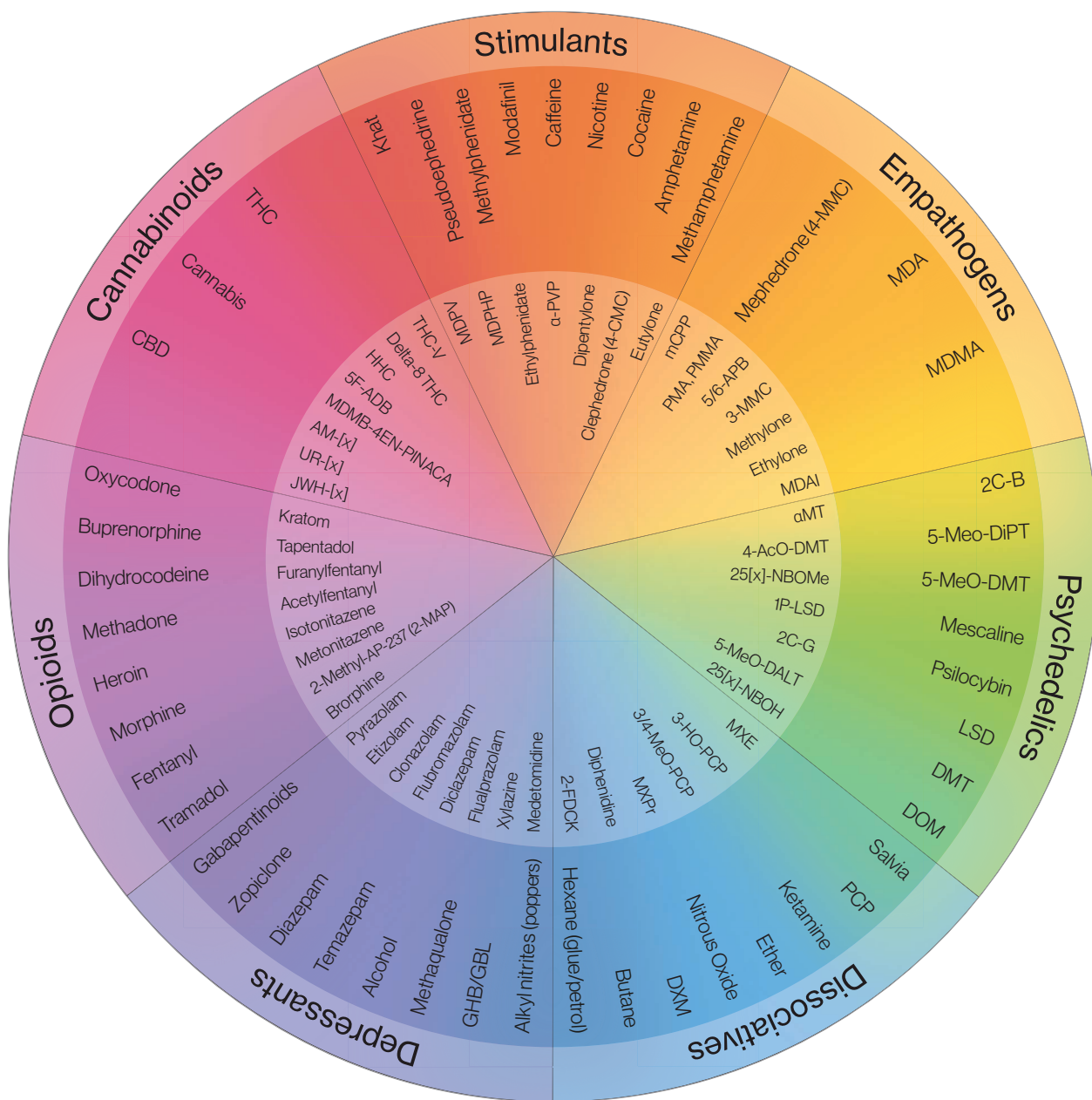


The Drugs Wheel
